Course Overview

This course is designed for students who show initiative and interest in Art, who are looking to enhance their skills. We will explore various mediums through drawing, painting, collage, sculpture, and more. Each student will use their prior knowledge from previous Art courses to investigate more thoroughly two-dimensional and three-dimensional projects. Students will use sketchbooks/journals in conjunction with projects and art history.

Assessment and Evaluation:

25% Sketchbook/Journal

65% Assignments

The art journal gives students a chance to gather resource and research material, and to do preliminary drawings. It is expected that the journal contain written material and data, handouts, brainstorming, sketches, critiquing assignments, medium experiments and independent drawings.

Assessment is an ongoing part of the process. A variety of assessment tools such as: self-assessment, peer assessment, observation, discussion, student/teacher conferences and projects will be employed throughout every topic. Grading criteria in the form of a rubric is presented at the beginning of each assignment.
