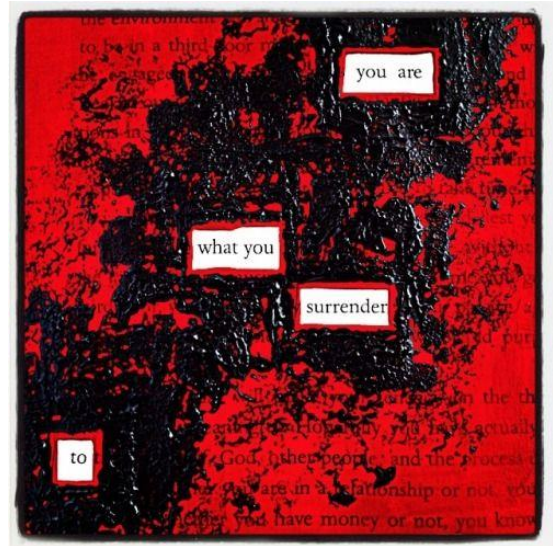


Found Poetry

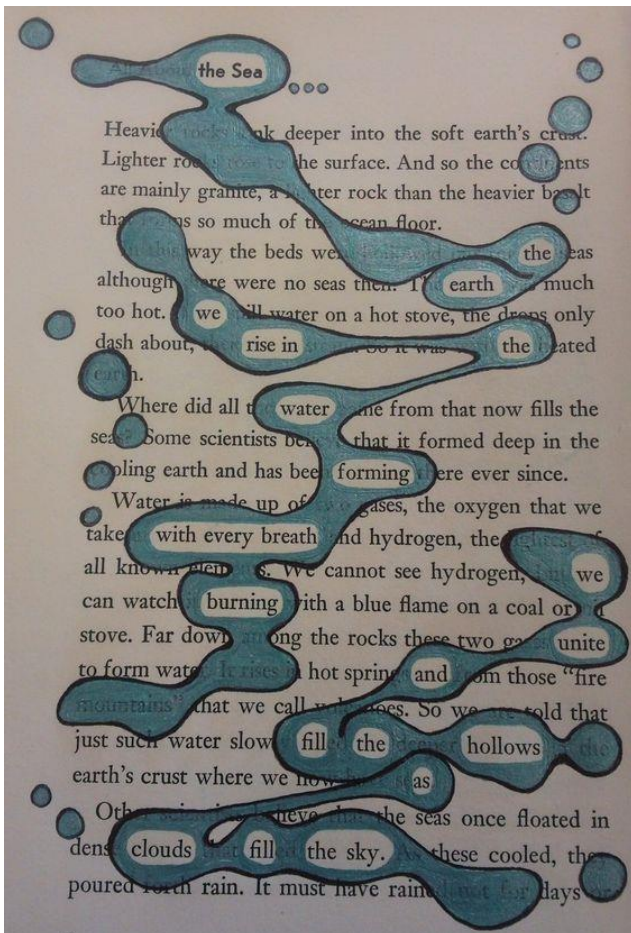

Assignment:

You will be creating your own found poetry using a copied page from a novel. This page must be filled with writing (no half pages!)



- You must browse the books in the hallways. Read the back, find topics that interest you, flip through the book.
- Choose a book and then begin your search for the perfect page. This page must be filled with writing. Look for a page with an exciting or enticing **anchor word**.
 - An anchor word is one that draws your attention and can produce further ideas, concepts, or thoughts. Anchor words are generally more complex words. In the example above, the anchor word was likely “surrender”. In the example below, the anchor word was likely “the Sea”. The poems are then created around this word.



- Once you find your word, begin to search through the page for words that complement your anchor word. Write these on a separate sheet.
- Put a sticky note with your name on the page you would like copied. Hand in to Mrs. Lodge.
- Once you have your copy and poem planned, you may begin creating your final found poetry!
