

MACBETH UNIT PROJECT

You will be creating a book that demonstrates your understanding of Macbeth. You must include the following components:

We will discuss the following in class:

Front Cover (5 marks)

Back Cover (5 marks)

Table of Contents (5 marks)

Summary of Play (15 marks – 5 marks each beg, min, end)

- Write a 1 page summary of the play from beginning to end.
- Use paragraphs – at least beginning, middle, end.
- Be sure to include the most important events. Use your notes!

Vocabulary (10 words) (5 marks)

- Choose 10 words from the novel that you do not know.
- Define each word (in your own words, as best you can).

Text Convo (5 marks)

- Use www.iFakeText.com to recreate one of your favorite conversations in the book.
- Change the words to modern day language that would likely be seen in a texting conversation.
- Must have at least 5 responses from each person (may need two pages if it does not fit into one screen page).
- Copy and paste your created conversation into a Word document.

Comic Strip (min. 6 panels)

(10 marks – 5 for pictures, 5 for text)

- You will create a comic strip of your favorite scene from Macbeth. Be sure to write the Act & Scene, as well as the title of your strip at the beginning.
- You must have a minimum of 6 panels (6 different sections)
- You must include speech bubbles. You may change the language to modern day text.
- Stick to the storyline – you may be creative with the comic to add humour but do not change what occurs in the play.
